WALK THE LINE

The use of geometric forms features heavily in spaces that draw inspiration from the Roaring Twenties, a time when flapper girls and jazz music reigned. The Natale sofa takes a cue from the decadent period

with striking linear stitching on its back and armrests. The sofa comes in a wide variety of fabric and velvet upholstery options so you can easily match this piece to your interior scheme.



GREEN WITH ENVY

The Gatsby sideboard draws inspiration from *The Great Gatsby*, an iconic novel by F. Scott Fitzgerald. It encapsulates the decadence of the Jazz Age with gold geometric details and an emerald hue. "Most of the art deco-style pieces from Snow Globe use gold electroplated stainless steel for a high-shine finish," says Boh. She advises not using any chemicals or cleaning agents on the metal elements. "If you're cleaning it with a damp cloth, wipe it with a dry microfiber cloth after that so as not to leave water spots," she adds.

DIAMONDS ARE FOREVER

Furnishings in rich shades contribute to the plush look of an interior. The Zoya swivel armchair is a choice pick: it features a distinctive mustard hue among the 60 colours available for the upholstery fabric, as well as a decorative diamond stitching on its backrest, and a stainless steel base in a brushed gold finish. Its curved form gives it a feminine look, particularly apt for a walk-in wardrobe or dressing room for the stylish lady of the house.
