With a depth of 40cm and an art deco-influenced design on its doors, it makes a beautifully functional addition to compact spaces. "The textured geometric motifs make the overall look of the sideboard more interesting," says Boh.

**PETITE WONDER**

A small side table is perfect for foyers with very tight corners. Crafted with electroplated stainless steel, the Zest table features a sculptural form and is available in various sizes and finishes. Choose from a gold, rose gold, silver or gunmetal finish to match the look of your interior scheme.



# Make an Entrance

**BETWEEN THE LINES**

A sleek console such as the Davey is another top pick for compact spaces. It features a marble top in black, white or green, and a frame made of electroplated stainless steel in a brushed gold hairline finish. Adds Boh: "A sleek console works well for smaller entryways as it doesn't add clutter or bulk."

**SHELF LIFE**

A display shelf is a wonderful way to showcase your favourite souvenirs and decorative vases at your entrance. Consider the Tabby shelf, which features a depth of 35cm. Says Boh: "There are many ways for you to style it; the shelves come in different heights so you can play around with your decor pieces by selecting items of different dimensions to create a layered look."



**TAKE A SEAT**

It's always useful to have a bench by the entrance. The Bridgette bench is among the top picks from Snow Globe. Available in various lengths ranging from 80cm to 140cm, the sleek proportions of this elegant piece make it a good fit even in petite spaces.



The entryway or foyer is the first area of your abode that guests will encounter, and the space that greets you upon your return home. "First impressions are important, and this applies to your home, too. The entrance should look welcoming and set the tone for the rest of your abode," says Juliana Boh, founder of furniture retailer Snow Globe.

Boh recommends installing a decorative mirror or artwork as a focal point of the space or creating an eye-catching feature wall to make your foyer pop. "A nice mirror will help to amplify natural light and make the space look bigger and brighter," she says. "You can also clad the walls in patterned wallpapers to really make this area stand out."
