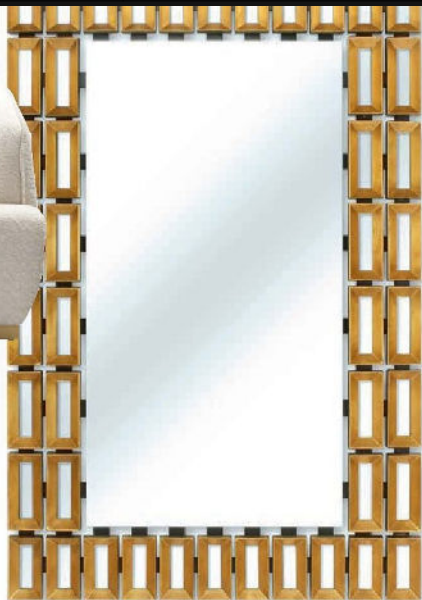




SEE THE LIGHT
