NEUTRAL GROUND

Playing with colour contrasts can create a dynamic look—choose a centrepiece in a subtle off-white or grey hue, and accessories in sprightly shades. Boh recommends the Bianca curved sofa for its sculptural form, and advises pairing it with colourful cushions as shown here to create a chirpy yet tasteful tableau in your living room.



MAKING WAVES

A colour palette comprising sea-inspired shades can evoke a calming atmosphere. Boh recommends the Halston armchair and Germaine sideboard, which feature tactile details and turquoise tones that hark to blue skies and the ocean.



Adds Boh: “Upholster the Halston armchair in a soothing blue fabric to make it the focal point of an entertainment room. The Germaine sideboard has beautiful green and blue details; if you only need one strong accent piece, this is it.”

LUCKY TANGERINE

Lively shades of mustard yellow and orange convey a retro-influenced look that adds warmth to an interior and are excellent choices for accent furniture. Boh advises matching pieces such as the Fernando armchair with wooden furnishings and items in earthy and off-white shades. “The Fernando armchair has a round shape that adds a nice presence to the living room.”
